# Why is there a Systematic Attempt to remove Black people at Denison University?

## Observations:

- (1) Refusal to grant funds for the BLACK ARTS by the DCGA.
- (2) The attrition rate of Black students.
- (3) Overt Racist tendencies ~~of~~ of white faculty.
- (4) Harassment of Black women on campus.
- (5) Avoidance of issues dealing with Blacks in classes not specifically designated as Black Studies courses.
- (6) No consideration by DCGA in social affairs re: White bands; Harry Chopin, Commander Cody & the Outlaws, Bromberg; white oriented socializers.

Denison doesn't encourage Black students to remain here, as a matter of fact they all but encourage us to leave. These are just a few examples of Denison's master plan to eliminate Blacks.
